We hope you will feel at home worshipping with us. If this is your first visit, or if we can be of help in any way, please make yourself known to one of those who welcomed you on arrival.

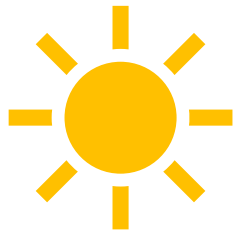
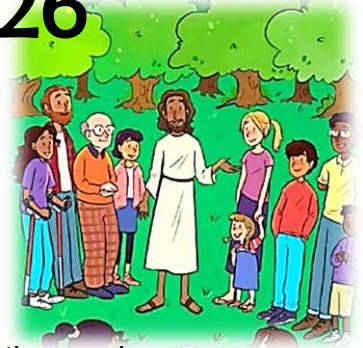

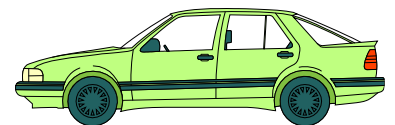

Walking to church:

There are good reasons we might have to drive to Emmanuel – our personal mobility (or that of someone we bring to church with us), the distance we live from the buildings, transporting equipment, really bad weather, or anxiety about walking in the dark.



There are also many good reasons to walk to Emmanuel – improving local air quality, improving our physical health, reducing our fuel use, leaving spaces in the church carpark for those whose need is greater than our own, or giving ourselves extra time to clear our thoughts & prepare for worship.

If we live further away, we might consider driving halfway and walking the remainder, and there is a good bus route from some areas, particularly for midweek & Saturday events.
